Exhortations & Commands Before Hebrews 10

The pastor's sermon leading up to Hebrews 10:19-25

Hebrews 2:1-4 Pay Attention

2 For this reason we must pay much closer attention to what we have heard, so that we do not drift away *from it*. ² For if the word spoken through angels proved unalterable, and every transgression and disobedience received a just penalty, ³ how will we escape if we neglect so great a salvation? After it was at the first spoken through the Lord, it was confirmed to us by those who heard, ⁴ God also testifying with them, both by signs and wonders and by various miracles and by gifts of the Holy Spirit according to His own will.

Hebrews 3:1 Consider Jesus

Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of a heavenly calling, consider Jesus, the Apostle and High Priest of our confession;

Hebrews 3:8, 15; 4:7 Do Not Harden Your Hearts

Do not harden your hearts as when they provoked Me, As in the day of trial in the wilderness,

Hebrews 3:12-13 Take Care, Encourage One Another

¹² Take care, brethren, that there not be in any one of you an evil, unbelieving heart that falls away from the living God. ¹³ But encourage one another day after day,

Hebrews 4:1 Let Us Fear

Therefore, let us fear if, while a promise remains of entering His rest, any one of you may seem to have come short of it.

Hebrews 4:11 Let Us Be Diligent

Therefore let us be diligent to enter that rest, so that no one will fall, through *following* the same example of disobedience.

Hebrews 4:14 Let Us Hold Fast

Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.

Hebrews 4:16 Let Us Draw Near

Therefore let us draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Hebrews 5:12 You Ought to be Teachers

For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you have need again for someone to teach you the elementary principles of the oracles of God, and you have come to need milk and not solid food.
